



Important Announcement Regarding 2010 RRGNs

As you know, the economy has been difficult for many and this has impacted participation and entries in karting events. Unfortunately, this includes this year's Road Race Grand Nationals. The NCK board has faced several tough financial decisions in recent months and has come to the difficult conclusion that there is only one way to be able to successfully stage the 2010 IKF Road Race Grand National event.

The Board has decided to take the following actions:

1. Restructure the event to fit into a three day window to reduce the total cost of the event. Unfortunately we must eliminate the Tuesday paid practice day. As things stand, sign ups for that day were minimal.
2. Add an extra hour of practice to all race days (Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday) for a full two hours each day. NCK decided to eliminate the "Trophy Dash" races scheduled for Wednesday and Thursday. These were not supported by entries and doing this frees up the time to make this change.

All classes will run as scheduled, on the proper day as previously announced. See the web site for an updated event schedule with revised start times for each race.

The entire NCK board wishes to apologize to any of our racers that may be adversely affected. The above actions are warranted in order for NCK to remain a viable racing organization and to reduce the financial risk of this event.
