



## Winter Classic at Laguna Seca 2012

The Northern California Karters proudly announce the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Laguna Winter Classic being held on Saturday, March 3rd.

Your club officers know this is close to our Buttonwillow event, and also near our Wild Willow Weekend event, but as before, to get dates at Laguna Seca is the luck of the draw and well after our other dates get established, so we do the best we can for you, the racers.

**As a reminder - Laguna Seca has a strict sound limit of 92 DB.** NCK testing has shown that most water cooled karts can easily make the limit with some need minor modifications such as silencers and air boxes.

- 125cc shifter karts require airbox and 18" silencer that is available from RLV.
- 80cc shifters require airbox and a 14" Moran-spec silencer.
- World Formula racers can usually make the limit.
- Yamahas can also make it with an air box and a **special silencer** placed over the outlet on the pipe. These silencers will be available at the track.

The race format will consist of four separate run groups. Each group will consist of a maximum of 35 karts and will get a minimum of three track sessions: Practice, Pre-Main, and the Main event. Every attempt is being made to group similar karts into each run group while also attempting to allow racers to enter a second class. As NCK is only allowed 35 karts per group that will cap the event at the **first 140 paid entries**. Entry will be on a first come first served basis. After that, there will be a waiting list.

Race group 3 is setup with "open" classes, meaning, if you want a second class to run, or can't fit in anyplace else, chose a class here – 4 stroke open for all 4 stroke engines, 100cc open for any 100cc clutch kart, 125/150 Open for Tags, TAGE, 80 and 125cc shifters, etc. Unlimited II for "Run What Ya Brung" IKF legal karts.
