



2012 MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION

Welcome back, all! We are asking all members to register into the membership database as soon as possible.

SOME IMPORTANT CHANGES

- Registration in the database is **mandatory**. Please click on the link below (in step 1) for registration.

- NCK annual memberships are \$75.00. This fee includes your kart number for the year. Novices: Please read the last sentence of this document before continuing. Please follow the steps below to complete your registration:

1. Go to the web site here: <http://www.dlbracing.com/default.aspx> and click the "Login" link.
2. If you are new to the Online Registration then use the "Create New Account" button. If you are not new, then enter your name (email address) and password and proceed to step 5.
3. Fill in all required information (including kart information). **You cannot enter an event** with no karts in your online garage. Click on "Create Account".
4. In the upper right, change "Views" to "Calendar".
5. Change the drop down menu under "Show" to "Northern California Karters"
6. Change "Calendar" date to "January 2011"
7. There is an icon showing a car in front of clipboard on the date January 31. Click on the icon showing the **car/clipboard**.
8. You must agree to the NCK rules and polices by checking the box on the left. Then choose "Proceed to Join/Renew NCK Membership"
9. Select your membership renewal option and kart number for the year.
10. Click on Continue.
11. Verify the information is correct on registration summary page.
12. Select payment choice. (Either PayPal or Check)

13. If paying by PayPal, you do not have to be a PayPal member. Select "Continue" on the left side of the screen (don't log in). Follow credit card instructions.

14. That's it! (but wait! There's more on the next page)

IMPORTANT NOTES

For all IKF renewals please deal with IKF directly (<http://www.ikfkarting.com/Contact.html>) . IKF membership is **not** required, but is **encouraged** for the following reasons:

1. You get a rulebook. We will be using IKF rules for all of our events and as such, you are responsible for knowing the rules of the class(es) that you run in.
2. You maintain your road race qualified license (red) for gridding.
3. For new road racers, you can get your novice license (yellow) signed off for three events and achieve road race qualification (red license).
4. Racers that do not have road race qualification (ie, if you do not have a red IKF license) will be treated as novices and placed at the rear of the grid.

Guess what? Once you've done it, you're done for the rest of the year. There's no self-addressed stamped envelope ****. It is easy stuff! That is, of course, once we have received your payment and completed forms!

Don't forget your password and email address!

It's all you'll need to enter events!

NOTES ON KART NUMBERS: All members will be assigned a kart number (no matter how many karts you have, this will be your number for all year). This is going to simplify scoring issues with no number duplications.

NOTES ON NOVICE (X) DRIVERS: All drivers that have not completed at least 3 road race events are classified as **novice** drivers. Also, if you do not have a Q on the end of your IKF card, you are a novice driver. All qualified drivers should update their yellow card to a red (qualified) IKF Road Racing License.

Because of the difficulty in the Scoring team seeing an "X" on a kart during a race, all **novice** drivers will have to select a number between 400 and 499 as their kart numbers.
